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Li Yang, MD, PhD, is a Research Scientist of Chinese Institute of Brain Research, Beijing, Professor and Deputy Director of Child and Adolescent Mental Health Centre of Peking University Sixth Hospital/Institute of Mental Health, Beijing, China. She is Committee member of Developmental Behavior Group, Chinese Society of Pediatrics, Committee on Child Rehabilitation of Chinese Society of Maternal and Child Health, Neurological Education Branch of Chinese Society for Cognitive Neuroscience, and Pediatric Rehabilitation Committee in Chinese Association of Rehabilitation Medicine. She is also in the Editorial Board of Chinese Mental Health Journal.

Professor Li Yang has been investigator in more than 30 research projects at PKUIMH on ADHD and other developmental disorders. Her research involves clinical diagnosis and evaluation, cognitive neuropsychology, psychiatric genomics and pharmacogenomics, as well as pharmacological and psychological treatment of childhood psychiatric disorders, which produced many papers on important academic journals in this field such as Molecular Psychiatry, the Journal of American Academy of Child and Adolescent Psychiatry, Neuropsychopharmacology, and the Journal of Child Psychology & Psychiatry, etc. She has won the Chinese Medical Science and Technology Award, and Peking University Distinguished Scientist Prize.
